


Before you start using this product please follow these basic guidelines:


1 Plug the Memory Module(B) to the DDR4 slot on the motherboard. Please refer to the motherboard manual for the installation location.



2 Remove the protective film of Thermal Pad on the Water Block(A).



3 Tighten the Screws(G) to enclose the Water Block(A) and Memory Module(B).




4 Connect the LED Y-Cable(D) onto the Water Block.

CAUTION


Please power off the PC and check the Positive and Negative ends on the connector before connecting the cable to motherboard. Connecting the wrong end can damage the LEDs.

Connect the MB SYNC Cable (D) to LED Y-Cable (E)







Connect the Waterblock onto the controller.

Set the DIP switch on the back side of the controller to assign the number of the controller

Connect the controller cable onto the motherboard (USB 2.0 9 pin) and controller.

Connect the power cable to the 4pin Molex connector and controller.
